

Luis Téllez Kuenzler

Mr. Téllez has over 36 years of experience in public policy, politics, and business, with senior leadership roles bridging finance and government. He served as Mexico's Deputy Secretary of Agriculture from 1989 to 1993, Chief of Staff to President Ernesto Zedillo from 1994 to 1997, where he helped restructure Mexico's financial package during the 1996 economic crisis, and Secretary of Energy from 1997 to 2000, leading production expansion and negotiations with OPEC.

From 2001 to 2003, Mr. Tellez was Executive Vice President at Grupo Desc, and from 2003 to 2006, Managing Director at The Carlyle Group. He later served as Secretary of Communications and Transportation from 2006 to 2009. From 2009 to 2015, he was Chairman and CEO of the Mexican Stock Exchange, where he oversaw the highest number of IPOs in its history and launched innovative investment vehicles raising over \$4 billion.

From 2015 to 2023 Mr. Tellez served as senior advisor and head of Mexico for KKR. In 2015, he founded LTK y Asociados, where he currently serves as Senior Advisor, providing strategic and operational counsel across industries in Mexico. Mr. Téllez has held board positions with Chubb, Sempra Energy, FEMSA, Cablevisión, Grupo Desc, among others, and currently serves on the boards of Técnicas Reunidas, Element Fleet Management, Grupo Aeroportuario del Pacífico, and Organización Cultiva.

Mr. Tellez earned a degree in economics from Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México and a doctorate in industrial chemistry from Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
